



Rick Kerestesy is Senior Vice President of Integrated Systems Solutions (ISS), a service-disabled, veteran-owned small business that provides professional and technical services to government agencies. ISS specializes in program management, organizational change, communications, advanced data analysis, artificial and augmented intelligence, strategic visualization, and systems engineering.
